

DELTA CONTINUING EDUCATION FULL CREDIT SUMMER SCHOOL 2017

Students have an opportunity to complete a secondary course during the summer. This is ideal for those who wish to complete graduation requirements, upgrade a course mark, or lighten next year's academic load.

In the blended program, students will have two days per week of classroom based instruction and three days of online instruction plus review and testing. Students will be expected to sign-on to their online program during the non-classroom days.

PREREQUISITES: Students enrolled in secondary school will need counsellor approval to assure prerequisites are in place.

NOTE: Full Credit summer school courses are fast paced and intensive due to the short duration of the course. Students must be able to work independently, be disciplined, and complete assigned homework which supports classroom instruction.
