**DELTA CONTINUING EDUCATION
FULL CREDIT SUMMER SCHOOL 2017**

Students have an opportunity to complete a secondary course during the summer. This is ideal for those who wish to complete graduation requirements, upgrade a course mark, or lighten next year's academic load.

In the blended program (Planning 10), students will have two days per week of classroom based instruction and three days of online instruction plus review and testing. Students will be expected to sign-on to their online program during the non-classroom days.

PREREQUISITES: Students enrolled in secondary school will need counsellor approval to assure prerequisites are in place.

NOTE: Full Credit summer school courses are fast paced and intensive due to the short duration of the course. Students must be able to work independently, be disciplined, and complete assigned homework which supports classroom instruction.

FEE: All graduated Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents under 19 years of age
All non-graduated Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents \$100 text deposit

All graduated, adult aged Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents \$550
plus \$100 text deposit

ID: **Student:** 2 pieces of identification required (one of which must be picture ID)
Proof of citizenship **and** proof of residency
Parent: Proof of residency if student is under 19 years of age

*****NOTE: The \$100 textbook deposit will be refunded in full upon completion of the course and return of the textbook. However, a \$40 processing fee will be applied to each and every change to the original registration, (i.e. transferring to a different course) or early withdrawal from the course. This amount will be deducted from your textbook refund. Withdrawals will not be accepted after the third week.**
