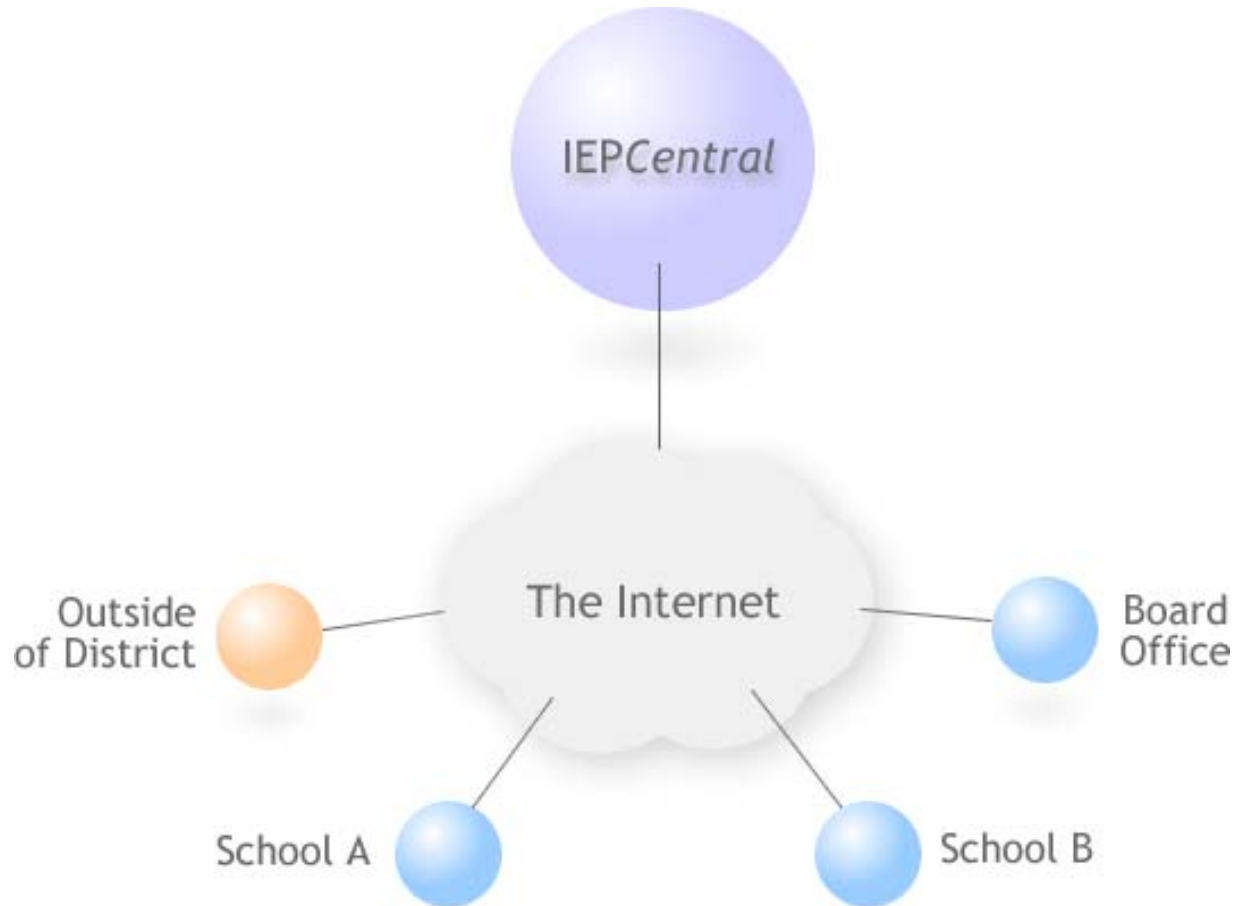


What is IEP*Central*?

- A secure, web-based application for the development, monitoring and reporting of progress for students on Individualized Educational Plans
- It's structured content provides a path to assist specialists in developing a student's IEP but is flexible enough to accommodate a variety of working styles



Anytime, Anywhere Access



Benefits of IEP*Central*

- Helps improve the planning process
- Makes IEP's easier to develop, revise and review
- Provides District-wide consistency in IEP's
- Gives easy access for all authorized staff to read a student's IEP
- Single point of access for IEP related resources such as District and Ministry forms
- Assists new staff in understanding the IEP process
- Helps parents understand IEP's and feel more supported in the process



Who must have an IEP?

- Identified students with an IEP
- Students with modified programs (learning outcome substantially different from prescribed curriculum)
- Students with significantly adapted programs
- Any students receiving 25 hours or more of remedial instruction per year by a person other than the classroom teacher

Who writes an IEP in IEP*Central*?

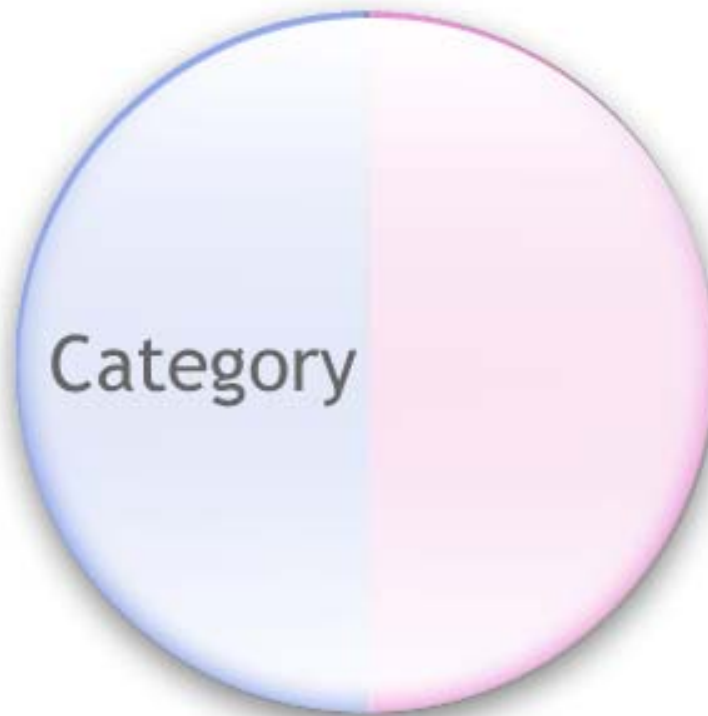
- The student's case manager is typically the writer of the IEP
- The IEP is always written in consultation with the parent or guardian and the classroom teacher

What is the role of the classroom teacher within *IEPCentral*?

- Classroom teachers will be involved as always in:
 - Assisting the Case Manager
 - Participating in IEP Meetings
 - Implementing strategies & adaptations that will help the student reach their IEP long term goals
- With *IEPCentral*, classroom teachers will be able to review the IEP's for all students in their school

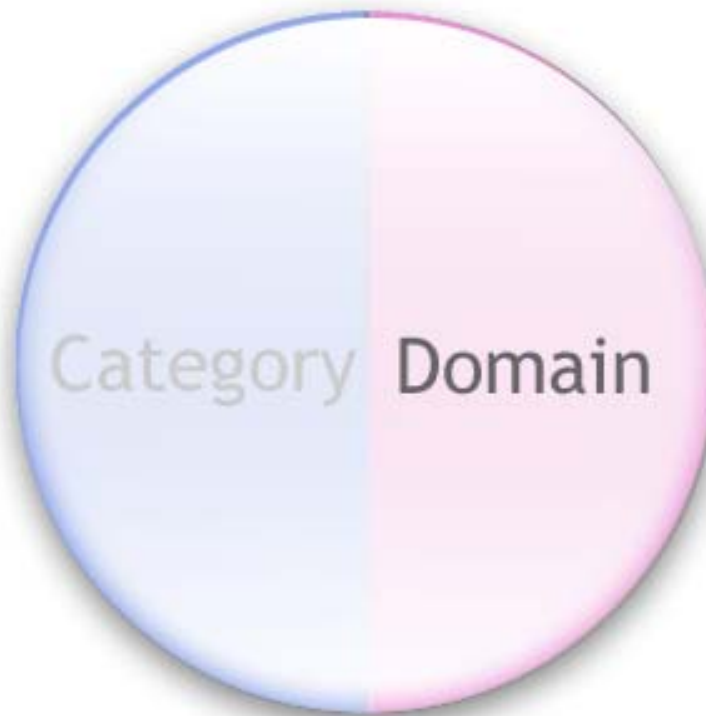

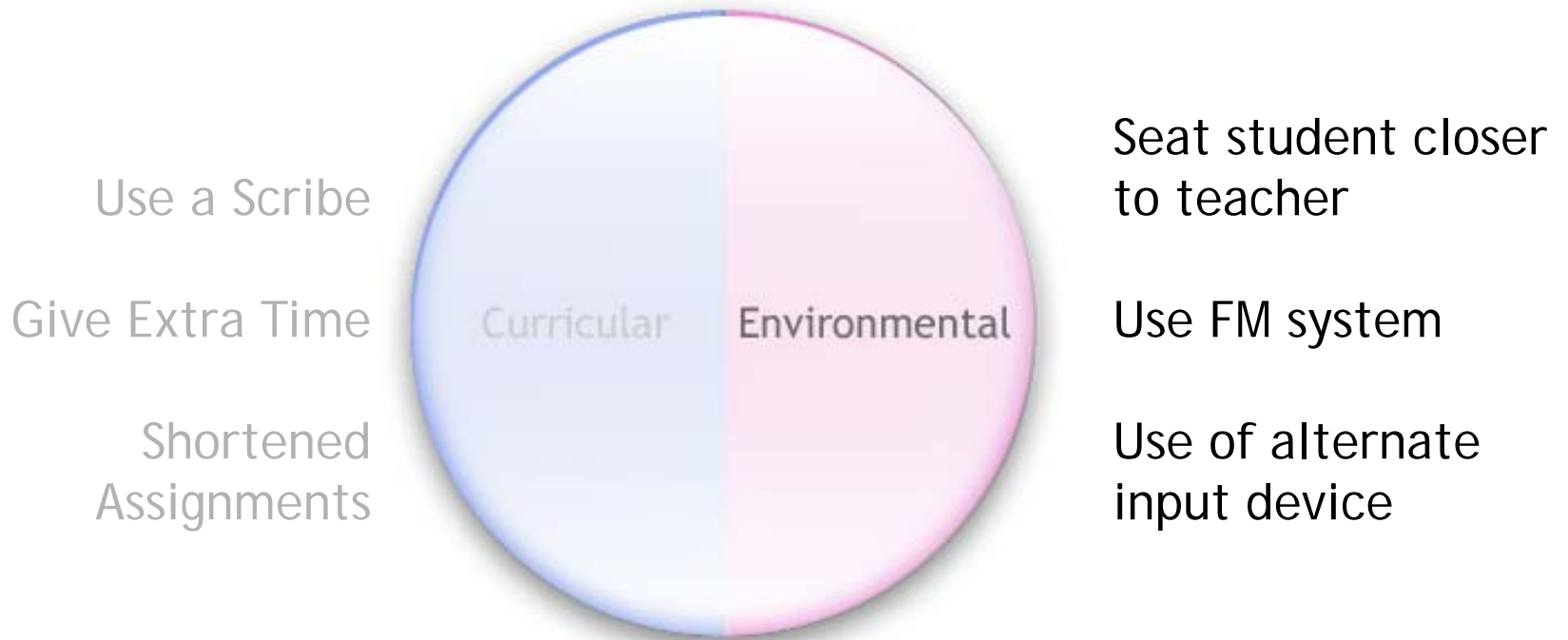


Examples of Adaptations
